



REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP)

Provision of Dining Hall Catering Services

The Services Department of the University of the Witwatersrand, requires the services of one or two experienced Catering Service Providers to operate the residence kitchens and dining halls. Tenderers to note the RFP document has two (2) components:

Component 1: RFP for Dining Hall Catering Services for Main Dining Hall (Students' Union Building); Knockando Dining Hall; Highfield Dining Hall; Convocation Dining Hall; and Jubilee Dining Hall.

Component 2: RFP for Dining Hall Catering Service for Ernest Oppenheimer Dining Hall. This component's pre-qualifying B-BBEE criteria invites EME & QSE (Level 1 to Level 4 with at least 51% black ownership). This is also subjected to University final approval. This component is only exclusive for EME & QSE who fit the criteria.
